## **Federal Stimulus Funds**

Since March 2020, the federal government has passed three relief packages in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to support K–12 schools. This support is called ESSER, which is an acronym for Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief. ESSER falls under the umbrella term CARES (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act) which provides economic stimulus to individuals, businesses, and schools. The allocations are determined using the Title 1 formula.
