Please take a moment to review some important updates below.

Building Office Hours

As a reminder, each school building will be open on Monday and Thursday from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM with a minimal staff working. All parents are asked to call during office hours, or email the administrative assistant or principal for assistance or to schedule an appointment. Access to the building will be limited to essential employees and scheduled visitors only. Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten Registration will be completed on-line for the 2020-2021 school year. It will be a two-step process. The first step is to complete the initial online Kindergarten Registration. You can access the online Kindergarten Registration form directly at:

In early June, you will receive a letter sent to the email submitted on the form with a unique code and instructions on creating a PowerSchool Parent Portal account. You will access your PowerSchool Parent Portal Account to complete the registration process.

Kindergarten Orientation will take place on the first day of school on Wednesday, August, 5, 2020. A parent or guardian will be asked to bring the Kindergarten student to school and attend the parent orientation session which will consist of lunch account information, bus information, a

question and answer session, and an opportunity to bring your child's immunization records and birth certificate.

The East Central High School Prom previously scheduled for April 17, 2020, has been cancelled. It will not be rescheduled for May or later this summer. Instead, the Class of 2020 will be permitted to attend Prom in 2021.

Graduation

After much consideration, we have reluctantly decided we will not be able to have a traditional graduation. The East Central High School Graduation Committee is meeting to develop a plan for a virtual graduation ceremony. The virtual graduation will be broadcast on YouTube on June 7th at 2:00 PM during the regular graduation date and time. After the broadcast, it will continue to be available for viewing on YouTube. In addition, all seniors will receive a free yard sign

sponsored and paid for by Student Council. More information, including how to get your yard sign and how seniors will participate in the virtual ceremony will be coming in the next two weeks.

School Campuses

As a reminder, both Dearborn County and Ripley County continue to be under a Level Orange travel advisory. Due to this, all school campuses are closed.
