Dear Sunman-Dearborn Community Schools Parents:

I have received several questions regarding e-learning and the Sunman-Dearborn Online Academy (S-DOA). I would like to take a few moments to explain the difference between the two programs.

E-Learning

E-learning is an instructional model that is provided to parents and students when school is closed either school-wide or corporation-wide. As an example, we provided e-learning during April and May when Governor Holcomb ordered all schools closed through the end of the 2019-2020 school year.

For the 2020-2021 school year, we will provide e-learning if a school or the corporation is closed due to an Executive Order issued by the Governor or if we are directed to close by the local health departments due to an increase in COVID-19 cases.

E-learning is usually 2-3 hours of work each day, depending on the grade level. It is not as rigorous as regular instruction due to the fact that it was not a choice any parent made, rather a set of circumstances requiring the use of e-learning. It is also typically implemented on short notice. Normally, it is not intended for an extended period of time. Due to COVID-19 and Governor Holcomb's Executive Order, we made the best of a difficult situation and implemented e-learning for nearly two months.

Sunman-Dearborn Online Academy (S-DOA)



S-DOA is a robust and rigorous instructional model parents can choose for their children. Instruction will be delivered live, recorded, and through various technology platforms. Parents and students should expect 5-6 hours of instruction each day. Homework, assignments, and extra practice will be in addition to instruction. Parents and students should expect between 1-2 hours of homework each day depending on grade level.

Due to staffing, enrollment in S-DOA will be on a semester basis, unless there are extenuating circumstances. As the attached flyer

states, S-DOA will provide for flexibility for students and parents. However, it will not provide flexibility to transfer between traditional and online instruction.
